2. **Coaching** – Appoint new club coach by end of January 2005. Develop the whole swimming programme within the club in accordance with LTAD guidelines and recommendations. Encourage senior swimmers, parents and existing qualified staff to pursue new or additional ASA qualifications.

3. **Volunteers** – Through our existing club volunteer co-ordinator - recruit, retain and reward senior swimmers and parents to take on roles within the club, to assist in its day-to-day running.

What do you feel has been the Club's main achievement / s ?

- 1) Moved quickly to identify possible club coach – with appointment pending (Jan 2005)
- 2) The change over from Charnwood LC to Soar Valley LC. Additional pool time was found at other pools as well and new timetable put in place. Swimmers and parents were kept informed of the changes as they developed via notice board, leaflets, newsletters and web site.
- 3) Maintained existing links with Local Authority and Serco throughout pool move and improved on links with other swim clubs. Assisted Leicester Knighton Fields SC and Kimberley SC in their Swim21 accreditation and provided several swimmers from Coalville SC with pool time at our session at L'boro Uni. Recently contacted by Belgrave SC, who will be seeking help from LTSC early in 2005 with regard to their Swim21 accreditation files.
